



Certificate III in Bricklaying and Blocklaying

Course Description

The Certificate III in Bricklaying and Blocklaying develops the practical skills and knowledge needed to work as a qualified bricklayer or blocklayer in the construction industry. Students will learn to construct walls, partitions, arches, and other structures using bricks, blocks, and mortar, while also gaining expertise in reading plans, using tools and equipment, and following workplace safety standards. Graduates will be ready to work on residential, commercial, and industrial building projects.

What will I learn?

28 units of competency: 20 core units + 8 electives

Students will learn to construct walls, partitions, arches and other structures using bricks and blocks while also gaining expertise in reading plans, using tools and equipment, and following workplace safety standards. Graduates will be ready to work on residential, commercial, and industrial building projects.

- Have demonstrated an IELTS level at score of least overall 6.0 or equivalent (test results must be no more than 2 years old). or demonstration of successful completion of at least General English at Upper Intermediate or English for Academic Purposes Upper Intermediate level.
- Have a suitable level of language, literacy and numeracy to complete course requirements with or without additional support that IMC is able to provide.
- Have successfully completed Australian year 12 or equivalent.
- Are at least at age of 18 on the date of course commencement.
- Please Note: All the students commencing this course are required to complete LLND test on the orientation day to assist IMC to identify student's needs for additional support during their study with IMC.



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
