Course Description

The Certificate III in Painting and Decorating provides hands-on training to develop the skills needed for a career in the painting and decorating trade. Students learn surface preparation, colour matching, wallpapering, decorative finishes, and safe use of tools and materials, while gaining knowledge of industry standards, sustainability practices, and workplace safety. Graduates will be job-ready to work as qualified painters and decorators across residential, commercial, and industrial projects.

04. ENTRY REQUIREMENT

There is no pre-requisites or specific entry requirement for this qualification. This course is available to all students and IMC requires that students are able to provide evidence that they:

- Have demonstrated an IELTS level at score of least overall 6.0 or equivalent (test results must be no more than 2 years old). or demonstration of successful completion of at least General English at Upper Intermediate or English for Academic Purposes Upper Intermediate level.
- Have a suitable level of language, literacy and numeracy to complete course requirements with or without additional support that IMC is able to provide.
- Have successfully completed Australian year 12 or equivalent.
- Are at least at age of 18 on the date of course commencement.
- Please Note: All the students commencing this course are required to complete LLND test on the orientation day to assist IMC to identify student's needs for additional support during their study with IMC.



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
