Certificate III in Solid Plastering

Course Description

The Certificate III in Solid Plastering equips students with the practical skills and knowledge to work as a qualified solid plasterer in the construction industry. The course covers applying plaster to walls and ceilings, creating decorative finishes, using plastering tools and equipment, reading and interpreting plans, and ensuring workplace safety. Graduates will be prepared to deliver high-quality finishes for residential and commercial projects.

What will I learn?

20 units of competency: 15 core units + 5 electives

This qualification provides a trade outcome in solid plastering for residential and commercial work. The qualification has core unit of competency requirements that cover common skills for the construction industry, as well as the specialist field of work, solid plastering. Solid plasterers apply plaster, cement and other mixtures to walls to create smooth or decorative finishes to interior walls and to render to exterior walls.

- Have successfully completed Australian year 12 or equivalent.
- Are at least at age of 18 on the date of course commencement.
- Please Note: All the students commencing this course are required to complete LLND test on the orientation day to assist IMC to identify student's needs for additional support during their study with IMC.



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
