



Certificate III in Wall and Floor Tiling

Course Description

The Certificate III in Wall and Floor Tiling provides the skills and knowledge to become a qualified tiler in the building and construction industry. Students will learn to lay and repair wall and floor tiles, interpret plans, use tiling tools and equipment, apply waterproofing, and create decorative finishes. This qualification prepares graduates to work on residential and commercial projects with precision and professionalism.

What will I learn?

20 units of competency: 17 core units + 3 electives

The qualification has core unit of competency requirements that cover common skills for the construction industry, as well as the specialist field of work, wall and floor tiling. Tilers work with materials like ceramic, glass, slate, marble and clay. They cut these materials and lay tiles on walls and floors, both interior and exterior. They may also add decorative touches to their basic work.

- Have demonstrated an IELTS level at score of least overall 6.0 or equivalent (test results must be no more than 2 years old). or demonstration of successful completion of at least General English at Upper Intermediate or English for Academic Purposes Upper Intermediate level.
- Have a suitable level of language, literacy and numeracy to complete course requirements with or without additional support that IMC is able to provide.
- Have successfully completed Australian year 12 or equivalent.
- Are at least at age of 18 on the date of course commencement.
- Please Note: All the students commencing this course are required to complete LLND test on the orientation day to assist IMC to identify student's needs for additional support during their study with IMC.
